AWARDS COMMITTEE

Award Nominations are open through August 7th. To date, there has been one submission for Service Tech of the Year. The committee anticipates at least two submissions for the Andy Gump Award. Veronica has emailed a personal invitation to those who submitted nominations last year to nominate their candidate again. However, the committee asks PSAI volunteers to continue spreading the word and encouraging nominations for all three awards.

CERTIFICATION COMMITTEE

Dear Board,

At our last Commission Meeting on May 18th, we examined the results of Certification Exams taken in 2025.

While the total number of Certifications was far below expectations (22 through the Learning Management System and 46 in-person), we looked at Exam Questions that were answered correctly by less than 70% of the respondents. Of the 60 questions on the Exam, 8 questions fell into this category. Prior to our next meeting in July, we are to suggest alterations and/or edits to these questions in order to increase the percentage of correct answers.

As stated in last month's Board Report and now with the low 2025 Certification numbers, we feel that conducting the 50-State Survey is even more crucial. By notifying the States that our 34-year old Certification Program is now available for both online training and testing, more States will approve our program as being valid in their states. As a result, our PSAI Certification numbers can return to previous levels of 175 -200 per year.

ACTION ITEM:

To adequately - and quickly - complete this survey, we need VOLUNTEERS in addition to the Commission to complete this task. We will have talking points, a database to track and to record information, and training for all who will be working with us. If any Board Member knows of someone that can help with this project, PLEASE let us know.

CONVENTION AND TRADE SHOW - Nov 3-5, 2026

The launch for registration for the 2026 Daytona Beach Convention and Trade Show began on June 9th!

As of now, most of the program is finalized and ready-to-go:

- Our Keynote Speaker is Susan Frew who will be speaking on practical applications of AI. She focuses on identifying workflow operational and managerial opportunities and then applying AI within those areas. This will be a “practical approach to AI” which should be of interest to our entire group.
- We will have 2 Breakout Sessions with 3 topics per one-hour time slot. The Breakouts will be: (1) Vacuum Technology with a 3 person panel (2) AI with Susan Frew leading the session as a follow-up to her Keynote Address (3) Cybersecurity.
- Jeff and Kelsey have compiled a list of 20 Roundtable Topics, of which the Events Committee will select the final 10. The list was created from a variety of sources - input from members on social media, popular topics from previous PSAI events, and even ChatGPT suggestions.
- As part of our new approach to keeping HOLLways as being “hands on,” we received 5 applications to participate. (One HOLLway will deal with vacuum technology which ties in with one of the Breakout Sessions.) We will be working with these companies to insure the continued success of these sessions.

VIRTUAL ROUNDTABLE

On June 24th, the topic will be “New to Business Roundtable.” This is a popular in-person Roundtable Topic and should therefore attract a good-sized audience.

Key Updates:

Z4.5 Project Timeline

The committee past a formal motion to approve project timeline outlined in the 'ANSI/PSAI Z4.5 — PROJECT MANAGEMENT TRACKER v4' file. The full project timeline can be referenced in this [LINK](#). The goal is to have the project published on, or prior to, April 28th, 2028.

Z4.5 Draft

The committee resumed work on Section 4 of the Z4.5. The committee established sub-committees to produce draft language for the following Section 4 headings:

- 4.2 – Servicing and Maintenance Requirements
- 4.3 – Provision of Toilets, Hand Washing and Shower Facilities
- 4.4 – Minimum Number of Toilets, Hand Washing and Shower Facilities

Next Steps

Continuing adding detailed bullet points under each Section 4 heading.

As each bullet point is finalized, a sub-committee will be formed produce draft language.

Our next team meeting will be held on Wednesday July 8th.

The committee remains engaged and aligned on the path forward. No board action is needed at this time.
